

A returned Georgian migrant is eligible to participate in the program if:

- ✓ She/he is a citizen of Georgia or a stateless person with the residence permit in Georgia;
- ✓ She/he was residing abroad illegally for more than one year, or had asylum application abroad;
- ✓ She/he has arrived in Georgia less than one year ago.

A returned Georgian migrant is not eligible to participate in the program if:



- ✓ She/he was residing abroad legally for studying program or by working contract;
- ✓ She/he is the participant of "The Willing Return and Re-integration" Project lead by the IOM or the participant of any other reintegration programs implemented in Georgia.

If you meet these criteria, you can get involved in the state reintegration program for returned Georgian migrants!

“Supporting Reintegration of the Returned Georgian Migrants” Program



About the Project

First time in Georgia, the Ministry of Internally Displaced Persons from the Occupied Territories, Accommodation and Refugees of Georgia with the financing of State Budget implements the program of “The Reintegration Assistance for Returned Georgian Migrants”.



The purpose of the program is to support the long term and sustainable reintegration process of the returned Georgian migrants.



Within the Program the returned Georgian migrants can benefit from the following Services:

- ✓ Meeting at the airport for persons in Special needs;
- ✓ General counselling after returning (for assessing needs and identifying opportunities of assistance);
- ✓ Provision of first aid and basic medicine, counting psychosocial rehabilitation (for returnees having severe, chronic and life-threatening diseases), to the returnees;
- ✓ Professional and re-training;



- ✓ Funding of micro business projects (aiming at establishing the source of revenue, taking into consideration the skills and abilities of the beneficiary);
- ✓ Providing temporary accommodation, when needed;



- ✓ Paid Internship (for 3 months, aiming at upgrading professional qualification);
- ✓ Legal Aid (Consultation on legal issues, providing representation in relevant structures, compensation of state's paid services);
- ✓ Referral to the relevant state or private (health, employing, educational, social, etc.) program.
